Thank you for the parent support we have received with our Homework Program. We are encouraging Home Reading each night with an aim for at least four nights of reading. This will help with strengthening their comprehension skills as well as helping to increase their reading fluency. Students are given 2 weeks to complete the homework with it due on a Friday.

MATHEMATICS

This term in Mathematics we are focusing on Addition, Subtraction, Money and Time. In weeks 4 and 5 students will participate in several assessment tasks that will serve as the foundation for our mid-year student reports. Students are being encouraged to continue to practise their times tables as having a good knowledge of their times tables is essential for developing strong mathematical skills, problem-solving abilities, and mathematical fluency.

LITERACY

Throughout Term 2 we will be focusing on strengthening our comprehension skills and enhancing our spelling skills through a range of Literacy tasks. Our writing component will focus on Narratives and Procedures. Throughout our Cafe Reading sessions we are focusing on the 12 Comprehension strategies. Each student engages in weekly reading conferences with their teacher to identify specific areas for improvement in their reading skills.

Cooking

We will participate in the cooking program again this term. In Term 1 the students enjoyed making Raspberry and White choc muffins and Savoury Muffins. This term we are going to make it more of a challenge for them. They are going to become quite the chef and create a whole meal to eat. We can't wait!
